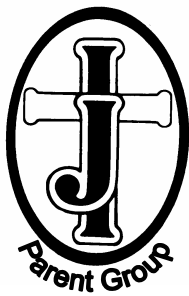

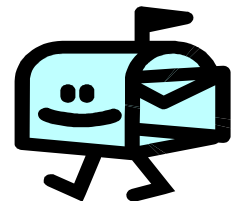

WEE DELIVER

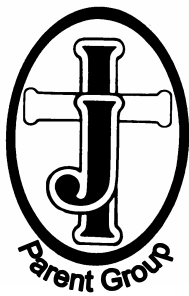

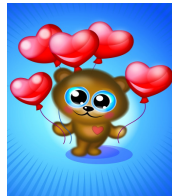


BOXTOPS FOR EDUCATION
