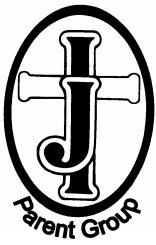

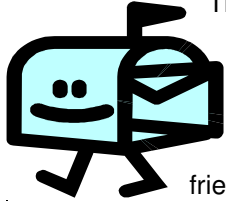
An annual program exploring the family life of New Hampshire's Woodland Indians including their shelter and hunting methods. This lesson encourages understanding of how early people survived this wilderness.

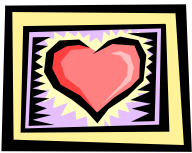
GIFT ROOM

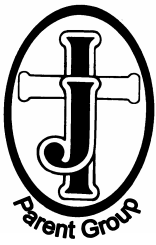
